Subject: Letter of intent for grant of [Public mobile radio trunking/Enterprise communication/Aeronautical data communication] service authorisation as under the Telecommunications (Authorisation for Provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026.

2. With reference to your application ID..... dated..... submitted by you for obtaining [Public mobile radio trunking/Enterprise communication/Aeronautical data communication] service authorisation under the Telecommunications (Authorisation for Provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026.

3. On the basis of the averments, submissions, information, representations, certificates, documents, declarations and undertakings submitted by addressee along with the aforesaid application, it has been decided to issue a letter of intent (“LoI”) for fulfilment of the requirements, within 45 days from the date hereof, as specified below, namely:—

- (i) Payment of ₹ [amount in words] only, as non-refundable entry fee in accordance with Schedule A of the Telecommunications (Authorisation for Provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026.
- (ii) Submission of initial guarantee of ₹ [amount in words] only, in accordance with sub-rule (1) of rule 25 of the Telecommunications (Authorisation for Provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026.
- (iii) In the event there have been any changes in any of the averments, submissions, information, representations, certificates, documents, declarations or undertakings that had been submitted along with the aforesaid application, then in such circumstances resubmit, on the portal the relevant information that would disclose and provide the required changes clearly referencing the application ID in respect of which they are being submitted.
- (iv) In the event clause (iii) is not applicable, submit an unconditional and irrevocable undertaking on the portal, reaffirming the undertaking under serial no. F under the title “Declarations and Undertakings” of the application that there is no change in circumstances or there are no subsequent developments to submissions made in the aforesaid application which renders the applicant ineligible or results in non-fulfillment of eligibility criteria as specified in rule 5 of the Telecommunications (Authorisation for Provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026.
- (v) In the event of overlapping license or authorisation as governed by serial no. 4 of the

application, submit an unconditional and irrevocable undertaking, in the form specified on the portal, relinquishing the overlapping license or authorisation, if any, from the effective date of authorisation in the form specified on the portal in accordance with sub-clause (ii) of clause (a) of sub-rule 2 of rule 7 of the Telecommunications (Authorisation for provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026.

4. The Central Government may, based on consideration of a written request for extension of time made by the applicant, if it is satisfied that there is a sufficient cause for non-fulfilment of the aforesaid requirements within the specified period, grant an extension for an additional period of 30 days for fulfilment of such requirements.

5. In case of non-fulfilment of the aforesaid requirements within the specified period, including during the extended period, if any, this LoI would be liable to be cancelled.

6. In cases where the applicant is submitting the initial guarantee as bank guarantee from any scheduled commercial bank or public financial institution, or performance bond from an Indian insurance company as per [clause (a) and (b) of sub-rule (1) of rule 44] of Telecommunications (Authorisation for Provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026, the bank or public financial institution or insurance company shall designate its branch located at [name of town or city] for receipt of an ink signed copy of letter regarding invocation of such guarantee.

7. On being satisfied that the requirements specified in this LoI have been fulfilled by the applicant within the specified period, [Public mobile radio trunking/Enterprise communication/Aeronautical data communication] service authorisation may be granted to addressee on non-exclusive basis under Telecommunications (Authorisation for Provision of Miscellaneous Telecommunication Services) Rules, 2026.

8. This LoI is subject to any amendment of the rules under the Telecommunications Act, 2023 or change in any applicable policy of the Government, in which scenario the terms and conditions of this LoI will be amended to reflect the same.

9. This LoI is issued without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the Central Government in the court cases, disputes or show cause notices issued under the existing licenses or authorisations granted to you.
